Application for an export licence for plant protection products according to Annexe 2.5 Number 4.2 ORRChem

1. principle

A licence from the FOEN is required for any person who wishes to export a substance listed in Annexe 2.5 Number 4.2.1 ORRChem or a preparation containing such a substance as a plant protection product. Any movement of a plant protection product containing a substance listed in Annexe 2.5 Number 4.2.1 ORRChem from an open customs warehouse, a warehouse for bulk goods or a duty-free warehouse to another country is also subject to the export licence requirement.
