1. Scope

These terms and conditions for supply and use govern the acquisition and use of hydrological data and information. "Hydrological data and information" refers to data and information on water quality and water quantity of surface water and groundwater collated by the Federal Office for the Environment (FOEN). They are subject to public law and have been developed in line with the terms and conditions of use for the federal authority datasets on opendata.swiss. Data acquisitions governed by separate agreements are excluded from these terms and conditions.

2. Scope of use

The data supplied is freely available. The customer may use the data for commercial or non-commercial purposes. Citation of the source is recommended.

3. Liability

Although the FOEN checks the data and information very carefully, no guarantee can be given that it is correct, accurate, up-to-date, reliable and complete.

Liability claims against the FOEN for material or non-material damage arising out of access, use or non-use of the published information or due to technical problems are excluded.

4. Fee

In general, the data is provided free of charge. Unusually high costs for data preparation may be invoiced. Billing is governed by the federal administration's General Fees Ordinance (AllgGebV, Art. 3) and the FOEN Fees Ordinance (Ordinance on the Fees Charged by the Federal Office for the Environment of 1 January 2020 (Art. 4 para. 1 letter c).
