Switzerland appreciates the opportunity to provide input to the co-facilitators' non-paper on possible elements of draft decision to be included in the Registry.

General remarks

The potential of the registry in its facilitating function is in making relevant information on individual nationally appropriate mitigation actions and the various channels of support available to the proponents and potential sources of support, respectively. Thus, Switzerland supports the registry in the form of a platform, light in structure, for voluntary participation and use by all relevant stakeholders. Thus, the registry should be set up and updated by the secretariat on the basis of submissions of Parties and other relevant stakeholders.

As the registry will have no executive function, the user-friendliness and outreach of the registry will be fundamental for its success.

In the separate section of the registry, nationally appropriate mitigation actions already implemented or with secured funding should be recognized along with a description of the mitigation actions and information on emission reductions, costs and source and type of international support, if any.

Information on individual nationally appropriate mitigation actions seeking support should follow a common structure. To this aim, the secretariat should produce a prototype of a respective template, based on the experiences from other initiatives and any factual information identified by the AWG-LCA. The template should allow for concrete information on NA-MAs ready for implementation as well as those yet to be fully developed.
